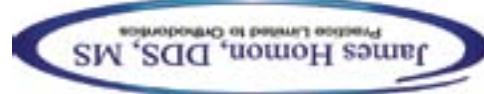

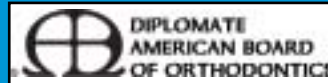

KIDSMILES TEAMS UP WITH THE BLUE JACKETS FOUNDATION

KidSMILES, a charitable pediatric dental clinic, was founded by Dr. Homon in 2009. KidSMILES is a non-profit dental clinic that makes dentistry affordable for all by only charging patients \$10 a visit. Currently, KidSMILES has over 250 dental professionals signed up to volunteer their services.

Lately, the volunteers have been working with the Columbus Blue Jackets, spreading the word about the importance of good dental health to local children.

During the months of February and March, Dr. Homon and the KidSMILES volunteer team visited local schools and distributed dental goodie bags to over 3,000 children. Stinger, the Columbus Blue Jackets mascot, came along for the trip, rollerblading through the school's hallways armed with a four foot long tooth brush. Together, Stinger and the volunteers educated and entertained the kids, making dental health fun while emphasizing the importance of it.

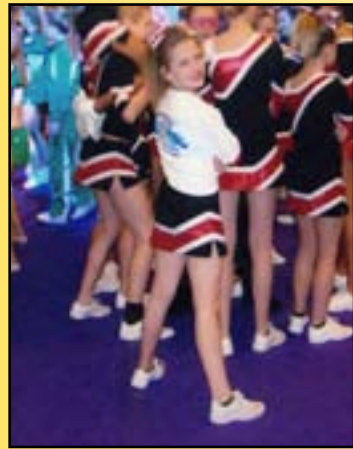
Recently, the Columbus Blue Jackets Foundation awarded their annual grants totaling \$500,000. KidSMILES was awarded a \$50,000 grant to help with the construction of a new clinic which will be located along Bethel Road. With this grant, we will be starting construction in the fall and will be ready to start treating patients by the end of the year.

Did you know that one of the greatest advances in modern day orthodontics came from NASA?

Moving teeth may not be rocket science, but we are happy to share their technology. During the space shuttle program, NASA developed a bendable metal that had shape memory in order to fit a satellite dish into the cargo bay. This new metal allowed them to fold up and store the dish and then it would spring into shape when they released it into space.
